### IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

This is a sponsored event which offers a great opportunity for you to raise funds for a Community cause, Project or Charity of your choosing. The Walk into the Sea is at 12mid-day prompt on Boxing Day.

All sponsorship monies raised can be split 50/50 with 50% to Paignton Lions Club (for Charitable purposes) and 50% to a Cause/Charity of your choice. If you haven't a chosen cause/charity then all sponsorship monies will go to Paignton Lions Club for Charitable purposes.

All completed sponsorship forms along with any monies and a completed registration form entitles the participant to entry. However you can still take part without this upon submission of a **£10 participation fee—Adults (£5—Under 16's) NOTE: Pre Registration preferred closing on Xmas Eve...see registration form.** Under 16s must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times in order to take part in this event. All participants **MUST** complete a registration form, for Insurance and Health & Safety reasons, to take part.

Fancy Dress is encouraged (but optional) for all participants and will be judged down on the beach at 11.45am. The Awards for Best Fancy Dress and Highest Sponsorship will be awarded as soon after the event as possible.

All sponsorship monies should be handed in on the day at Registration or forwarded to **Lion Treasurer Alan Tozer 54 Victoria Park Road, Torquay. TQ1 3QJ.** **PLEASE DO NOT** send any sponsorship monies direct to your chosen cause, it is a condition of participation that all monies will be collected by Paignton Lions Club and distributed to your chosen cause as soon after the event as possible. Sponsorship monies can be collected from you after the event if necessary, please arrange with us at time of Registration. **You can also donate via our "Just Giving" Page too.**

All Reasonable precautions have been taken to ensure the safety of the event and all those taking part. To state the obvious, the sea conditions will be cold and the weather conditions may be also. If you have any medical conditions please seek medical advise before taking part. It is advisable to ensure you have either a Warm towel or clothing to wrap up in as soon as possible upon exit from the sea. It is NOT advisable, or encouraged by the event organisers, for you to run into the sea, the event clearly states "Walk into the Sea", to prevent any trips/falls that may result in injury to you or others. Entry and Exit to/from the beach is via the indicated area only. Medical Volunteers, Coastguard and RNLI (the latter 2 unless called out) will all be in attendance on the day for your safety, however if you have, or you see, an issue, medical or otherwise, that may affect yours or someone else's safety then please raise the alarm immediately. **COVID-19 SAFE MEASURES... ## **COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) Safety Measures**

**Please adhere to the following plus any instructions issued by the Event Marshalls and/or the Public Address System Announcements on the day!**

- 1. If you are feeling unwell and suspect Covid-19 symptoms, please stay at home.**
- 2. Track and Trace—please make use of the NHS Track & Trace QR Code or ensure you have registered with your contact details.**
- 3. Face Coverings to be worn by all participants, NOT to be worn into the Sea so please discard into receptacles provided as indicated on the day.**
- 4. 2m social distancing bubbles of six have been created for your Safety, please adhere to them.**
- 5. Please be mindful of social distancing at all times, both the beach and the sea are big enough areas for you to adhere to this easily.**
- 6. Please make use of the hand sanitisation stations provided.**
- 7. To assist with social distancing each row of bubbles will go off into the sea 15 Seconds apart.**
- 8. To enable us to comply with Council stipulations, Spectators are dissuaded from attending this year's event to help control the spread of the virus...*sorry out of our control!* However it is a public area so anyone deciding to attend are asked to comply with..... **Hands**—Make use of Sanitisation stations, **Face**—Face coverings to be worn, **Space**—2m Social distancing at all times. Please also use the NHS Track & Trace QR Code provided on site.**
- 9. Illness reporting –Anyone feeling ill and suspecting Covid-19 symptoms whilst attending the event are to report to Registration immediately who will summon medical assistance.**

We are mindful that some may find these measures an inconvenience, this we fully understand but our responsibility is to ensure that the event is safe for everyone, including our volunteers, to enjoy. Without these measures, which have been implemented inline with the Public Safety Advisory Group and the Council Events Team, we would not be able to put the event on this year, we thank you all for your understanding.
